TRAIL MANNERS

Good manners is the grease that helps people get along with each other avoiding friction.

- **UNDER 16 MUST WEAR A HELMET.**
- Be aware of the effect **your** actions have on others, their horses and their property.
- Do not upset your co-rider's horses.
- Ride at a quiet, controlled pace.
- **NEVER PASS OTHERS AT A GALLOP.**
- Keep a safe distance... don't crowd others.
- **STAY WITH A DISMOUNTED RIDER**
- Respect the property of others. (ie: lawns, farm fields, crops, groves, livestock, etc.)
- Leave gates as you found them: Open gates should remain open. Closed gates should remain closed.
- **DO NOT PASS THE TRAIL BOSS or drop behind the drag rider.**
- Stay with the trail boss on the same side of the road. Do not split the road.
- Clean up after your horse. Pick up manure or spread it depending on where you are. Do not clean your trailers out when you unload.
- **NO PROFANITY ON ANY SFTR EVENTS.**

REMEMBER! If you mind your manners others won't mind when you and your horse return to ride.

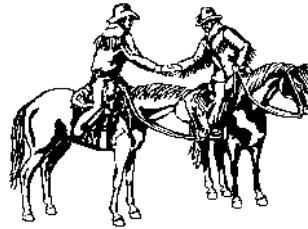


VARELA FFA SWEEPS THE SO. FLORIDA FAIR!!!

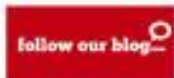

MARCH 25 REDLAND 100 RIDE

My second Redland 100 Ride in the month of March will take us to the farthest reaches of Southeast Miami-Dade County on Saturday March 25. We will explore the farmlands and canal Greenways way east of US 1, not far from Biscayne Bay. Those canals get very clear as they get closer to the bay and in many cases you will be able to clearly see fish and plants 25 feet underwater. Might see some mama manatees and calves if we are lucky, as they like to come into those canals at this time of the year.

We will ride for about 4 hours and will have a one hour lunch stop at a halfway point. Bring plastic or cash for lunch or you can also bring lunch with you. Also pack water on the trail. If you want to water your horse after the ride you

must bring your own water and bucket.

We are riding a loop that will take us back to the rigs, so there is no need to shuttle. The loop is approximately 11 miles. Make sure your horse's feet are well protected, either with shoes or boots.

Because most of you are not familiar with the area we'll be riding, we are meeting at the Harris Field (Rodeo Grounds) and will caravan to the trailhead. Be at Harris Field no later than 8:30 am. We are driving out of there at 8:45 am sharp, and will ride out from the trail head at 10:30 am. That will give you about an hour to tack-up. Please do not ask us to hold-up the ride if you are running late.

EVERGLADES NATIONAL PARK RIDE

We are once again heading out to ride the horse trails at the Everglades National Park. The ride will take place on Saturday March 11, 2017. The route I've picked will take us through the Pineland Trails of the Long Pine Key Area. It includes several miles through the largest remaining Dade County Pine forest in the world, approximately 8,000 acres. We will also ride through an open saw grass prairie, hardwood hammocks, and old reclaimed agricultural lands now part of the everglades restoration project.

Due to the rocky nature of the oolite and limestone footing, it is highly recommended that your horses be shod or wear protective boots. Because the terrain is also slippery and at parts uneven, this ride will be a mostly walking ride. If you, or your horse, have the "need for speed" this ride is not for you.

Bring water and lunch with you on the trail. Also bring your own water and bucket if you want to water your horse after the 4-5 hour ride. There is a clean lake at the trail head, inhabited by alligators, where you can draw water with a rope and bucket. The shore is too rocky and high for horses to reach down and drink. The trailhead and the trails are totally primitive. No bathrooms, or should I say, you have over half a million acres of unisex bathrooms with built in privacy shrubbery. Just make sure you know the difference between poison oak and the endangered Shadow Witch Orchid.

We will ride out at 10:30 AM from the Pine Glades Lake trail head (directions below). Please do not call a few minutes before the ride asking us to please delay the start. This is a long ride that requires an early start, so in fairness

to all who get there on time we will have zero tolerance for delays. If you have never been there, or it's been a while since you been there, meet me at the Robert is Here Fruit Stand at 8:50 am (I'll be leaving at 9 am sharp) and follow me to the park.

To get to the park go south on 192 ave or 217 ave to SW 376 Street (State Rd. 9336) AKA Ingraham Highway. Turn west and go to the park entrance. You will have to pay a per vehicle admission. At the toll booth (exactly) reset your odometer to "zero". Continue west on the main road as if you were going to Flamingo Point. At 8.7 miles slow down and start looking for an unmarked hard to see dirt road on your left. The road is at exactly 9 miles from the toll booth providing you have not installed aftermarket large rims and/or tires in your vehicle. If you miss the dirt road, making a U turn will be very difficult, if not impossible. Go about 1/2 mile on the dirt road and you will see the lake. Park on either side of the road but leave room for rigs to get in and out. Do not park in the open space near the lake as this is the only place we have for turning the trailers. If you park there you will be blocking a lot of people.

If you are coming from Broward, take the Turnpike South and drive it until you run out of turnpike at Exit # 1. Continue on S. Dixie Hwy (US 1) to SW 344 St and turn west. Go west to 192 ave (Robert Is Here is on the corner) and either wait for me there or continue to the park.

As always. Don't leave home without your Coggins. Contact me if you need any additional information or words of encouragement.

PARADE of BREEDS ... APRIL 9, 2017 AT THE FAIR

We have been invited by the Miami-Dade County Youth Fair to stage a Parade of Breeds at this year's Fair. The arena event will start at 3:30 PM on Sunday April 9. You must be at The Fair no later than 1:30 PM and ready for the parade by 2:30 PM. We enter the arena at 3:30 PM. Horses will be hand walked, without saddles, during the presentation. Handlers must be proficient in controlling their horses in a safe and orderly fashion, as there will be many horses present in the arena; and we will have a well-attended crowd in the stands.

As the horses enter the arena, a short description of the breed's origins, traditional, & current uses will be narrated to the audience. Handlers should wear apparel representative of the breed's history, or present day use in the various disciplines. We can assist you in choosing your attire, but remember to be creative and have some fun with it. If you have halters that are associated with the breed, use them. If your horse breed normally shows or works in braids, go for it!

Each handler will be paired with a child from one of the many community agencies and schools the SFTR serves throughout the year. The children, most of whom will be special needs students, will also assist with the narration.

Some of the breeds we are looking for are: AQHA, TB, Appaloosa, Paso Fino, Peruvian Paso, Tenn. Walker, Missouri Fox Trotter, Ky. & Rocky Mountain Saddle Horse, Shetland & Welsh Pony, Gypsy Vanner, Friesian, Falabella/Miniature, Haflinger, Belgian, Shire, Clydesdale, Percheron, PRE (Andalusian), Fla.
