TRAIL MANNERS

Good manners is the grease that helps people get along with each other, avoiding friction.

- **18 & UNDER MUST WEAR A HELMET.**
- Be aware of the effect **your** actions have on others, their horses and their property.
- Do not upset your co-riders' horses.
- Ride at a quiet, controlled pace.
- **NEVER PASS OTHERS AT A GALLOP.**
- Keep a safe distance... don't crowd others.
- **STAY WITH A DISMOUNTED RIDER**
- Respect the property of others. (ie: lawns, farm fields, crops, groves, livestock, etc.)
- Leave gates as you found them: Open gates should remain open. Closed gates should remain closed.
- **DO NOT PASS THE TRAIL BOSS or drop behind the drag rider.**
- Stay with the trail boss on the same side of the road. Do not split the road.
- Clean up after your horse. Pick up manure or spread it depending on where you are. Do not clean your trailers out when you unload.
- **NO PROFANITY AT ANY SFTR EVENTS.**

REMEMBER! If you mind your manners others won't mind when you and your horse return to ride.

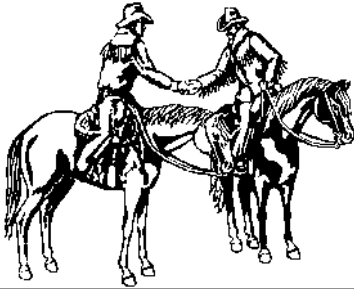

RIDE IN THE EVERGLADES NATL. PARK ON THE PINE LAKE RIDE - SAT. FEB. 7

Each year we trek through trails weaving through tall pine forests, past pools where gators sunbathe (at a safe distance), through prairie grasslands & up high onto the expansive deer mounds. There is also a section of a python graveyard from years ago, which we may be able to find!

All this, and more, awaits you on the **Pine Lake Ride**, on **Sat. Feb. 7**. We generally caravan & follow this schedule, so no one gets lost: Meet TB Mike Maldonado at **8am** at Robert Is Here fruit stand (19200 SW 344 St.). We will leave at 8:30 and drive the Ingraham Hwy (#9336) to the toll entrance of the Everglades Natl. Park. **At the toll booth, set your odometer/mileage for 9 miles.**

At 8 miles, start slowing down. At **9 miles** you will see a **dirt road** on your **LEFT**, which takes you to Pine Lake. The main park road down to Pine Lake has **NO** room for turning around – if you miss the turn-off you will either have to back up or drive a distance ahead to correct the issue. At that left turn, drive the dirt road to the lake & turn around **before** you park. Do **NOT** park by the lake. We should be there 9-9:30, tack up &

ride out around 10am, for approx 2-3 hrs.

Please bring your water, snacks, lunch, bug spray, sunscreen, raincoat (in case). Kindly wear a **yellow/gold SFTR T-shirt** so others out hiking, cycling or riding will see us & yield trail space! This ride is doable by juniors – all juniors 18-under **must** wear a helmet. Remember there is pinnacle rock & lots of trees, & any fall would be tough. Hoof boots suggested for horses. We leave No Trace along the trail or at the trailers when we leave – so police your area & take your poop home please.

This is a special once a year ride, & Mike has led the way many, many times. Please bring your gps so you too can learn the route! The wildlife is a treat, the palmetto & pine stands are amazing, and from atop the deer mounds one can see a breathtaking view of the Everglades. You will want to do this ride!! Please RSVP to Mike 305-331-7599 so he knows to wait for you at Robert Is Here. If you decide to ride, & drive there by yourself, please RSVP this info to Mike so you are included in the ride & he can BOLO for you. See you there!
